Applicants sought for the Napa County Housing Commission

NAPA – The County Executive Officer announces two openings on the Napa County Housing Commission, due to an expiring term and a vacancy, representing the following categories: Tenant Commissioner and Tenant Commissioner (over 62) – with terms commencing upon appointment and expiring October 2019. The Housing Commission was created in April 2007 by the Board of Supervisors for the purpose of advising and making recommendations to the Board of Supervisors on matters that come before the Napa County Housing Authority, including: a) operation and management of farmworker housing centers operated by the Authority; b) allocation of the proceeds of the annual assessment established for County Service Area #4 and ensuring that said proceeds are audited every two years; c) expansion of existing farm worker housing centers or the creation of new centers; and d) advising the Board on appropriate use of housing funds for affordable housing development projects. The Napa County Housing Commission meets on the fourth Thursday of the month in Napa. Anyone interested in consideration for appointment must submit a completed application form.
