UPDATE! Applicants sought for the Napa County Advisory Board on Alcohol and Drug Programs

NAPA - The County Executive Officer announces ten openings on the **Napa County Advisory Board on Alcohol and Drug Programs**, due to vacancies and expiring terms, representing the following categories:

- Two **Recovering Community**, with one term to expire January 1, 2020 and one term to expire January 1, 2021,
- Five **Interested Citizen**, with one term to expire January 1, 2019 and four terms to expire January 1, 2021,
- Two **Student Members (Shared)** with terms to expire January 1, 2021, and
